Our mission is to promote the education and earned benefits of all retirees of Kern County, advocate the safeguarding and continuation of Kern County retiree pension and health benefits, provide avenues of support and information for Kern County retirees and beneficiaries, ensure proper and necessary representation on the Kern County Board of Retirement, and participate as an integral contributor in our Kern County communities' quality of life.

Greetings to our 4500+ members, all of us at your RE-OKC Board hope you are doing well and staying healthy and finding ways to be happy and involved. It is great to see our luncheon numbers growing, and last meeting there were approximately 225 attending. I share with you again the importance of our website and how it may help you with many things during your retirement.

We continue to work with KCERA (Kern County Employees Retirement Association) to make sure you have access to your retirement information. Their doors are open and are fully staffed to assist you with your special needs. Their website and phone number are: <a href="https://www.KCERA.org">www.KCERA.org</a> (661-381-7700).

You know as seniors we seem to be targeted for all types of scams; some have been around for a long time and some much more recent. Consider this: family members or very close friends post videos online, "AI" only needs a few seconds to capture their voice you know and use it against you. For example: you receive a call from your granddaughter, or a very close friend, who sounds just like your granddaughter, or your very close friend, and she tells you of a situation she is having and needs money to keep from some terrible situation she will be in if she doesn't pay. This scam does happen and is not unusual. Scammers can alter caller IDs to display their name, or they can say that their phone died and are using some other phone. Before you get your wallet, you need to ask questions that only the two of you would know (nothing easy) and even say you

will call her back (if she is not using the dead phone issue). Don't give in, you must know who you are talking to before you give anything away (especially \$ and information).

Keep your personal information to yourself: I received two calls just the other day from people that were difficult to understand (very heavy accent) requesting my Medicare card number to give me stuff that I didn't order or need. They said they had information that I had pain in my back and needed my card number to send me this stuff. When I asked a few questions they hung-up on me. Scammers will always be around, and you do not need to be their target. Keep your information to yourself. If something interests you, call your doctor or the Medicare phone number on the card, but not the number that they gave you. Stay safe, there is always someone out there that would take your retirement if you let them.

You will find items like News & Information – covering REOKC Luncheons, Annual Health Fair, Special Notices, Articles on Pension Initiative, Blue Zone Events, Levan Classes, Kern County Elder News and REOKC Board Members and volunteers.

There are also links to available Resources such as retirement information from KCERA, KC Deferred Comp (VOYA), California Retired County Employees Association (CRCEA), State Association of County Retirement Systems (SACRS). California Association of Public Retirement Systems (CALAPRS) and Retired Employees Association (RPEA).

There is information on and links to the Credit Reporting Agencies, National Hotlines for information or to report Fraud Complaints, State Agencies to report fraud, and government agencies Kern County Government and State of California.

Finally, information and links are provided for our Affiliates: Cruise Port, Levan Institute of Lifelong Learning, Pacific Group Agencies (PGA), and STRATA Credit Union.

return the Enrollment Form; your existing benefits will automatically continue into the 2026 plan year.

Submitting your form on time ensures your updated or new benefits will begin without delay on January 1, 2026.





# NO MORE PAPER CHECKS FOR FEDERAL PAYMENTS

A new executive order states that beginning September 30, 2025, the U.S. Treasury will stop issuing paper checks for federal disbursements, moving to electronic payments instead.
